**Safety Rules:**

Each competitor must wear a safety helmet with a strap fastened under the chin and a buoyancy jacket (article 19.2, ICF Canoe Slalom rules). The buoyancy jacket must comply with the current industry standard that meets ISO 12402-5 (level 50) or any national standards that meets the same requirements and be ICF registered (article 19.2.1, ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

The safety helmet must comply with EN 1385 and be ICF registered (article 19.2.2, ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

**Rescue:**

There will be water rescue along the competition canal to ensure competitors safety.

**Local Security:**

There will be security on the venue. As usual, small items should not be left unattended or overnight and personal items should be taken care by its owners.

**Transportation support:**

Organizing Committee will support teams in transporting boats from airport to course and back to airport.

There will be transport from the hotels listed below to the course and back to the hotels. Even if your team is not staying in one of those, you can use transportation.
