



## 2007 Slalom World Championships

September 19-23, Foz do Iguassu - Brazil

## Term of Responsibility

ENTRY OBJECT: Participation in the 2007 Slalom World, to be held from September 19 to 23, in Foz do Iguassu, Parana State.

- 1) ITAIPU CANAL ESPECIFICACIONES: Itaipu Canal approximately: 420 meter long, 8,2 meters drop and 12,5 m/s flow, with real possibilities of accidents with personal injury and equipment damage, for which the event organization takes no responsibility.
- 2) PROGRAMME AND RULES: Are posted at the event website [www.foz2007.org.br](http://www.foz2007.org.br) , and the ICF- International Canoe Federation website, [www.canoeicf.com](http://www.canoeicf.com). In this act participants are notified and acknowledge the competition programme and international rules.
- 3) PARTICIPANTS PHYSICAL CONDITIONS: All participants athletes must be in perfect health and physical conditions demanded for an international canoeing slalom competition.
- 4) PHYSICAL SAFETY CARE: All event participants are obliged, in first place, to care for the personal and other participants physical safety.
- 5) IMAGE RIGHTS: The Slalom World Championships Accreditation Card is property of the Organizing Committee and may be cancelled at any time, at its exclusive discretion. When bearing this card I consent to be filmed, televised, photographed, identified and recorded during the 2007 Slalom World Championships under the conditions and for the purpose set forth by the Organizing Committee, inclusive for the promotion of the event, the course or the sport in the future. I hereby agree that any photographs taken by me during this event will only be used for personal and non-commercial purposes, except with prior consent in writing, from the Organizing Committee. I also waive any claim related to the use of such images and of my name, exempting the Organizing Committee from any obligation related thereto.
- 6) RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURIES AND DAMAGES: The participants are aware that the accreditation card for access to Itaipu Binational is restricted to the competition area, being prohibited any other access within the limits of the Itaipu property. In addition, any injuries or damages caused by any participant will be his/her responsibility. The Team leader and the participant federation will be answerable for the payment of injuries and/or damage costs.
- 7) ACCIDENT INSURANCE - INDIVIDUAL: Access to the competition area, inside Itaipu Binational property, will be granted to participants whose delegation proves existence of worldwide accident insurance that covers the individual.
- 8) LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ATHLETES UNDER THE AGE 18 YEARS OLD: The team leader will be invested of the legal responsibility for athletes under the age of 18 years old.

# Itaipu Training Rules

Brazilian Canoe Confederation and Itaipu Binational is pleased to welcome all teams and athletes that will represent many countries from all continents in the 2007 Slalom World Championships.

Itaipu is one of the biggest and most important Brazilian companies, with a big participation in Brazilian economy and even greater in Brazilian energy structure, being responsible for 24% of Brazilian and 95% of Paraguayan electrical energy generation. Therefore, due to its importance and organization Itaipu is considered National Security Area, including the area in which the Piracema Park is in. Rigid behavior principals are observed in all its area.

After Slalom Pan, we saw some inappropriate attitudes of a few athletes, in order to respect Itaipu Binational behavior and security principals, the competition organization got some rules from Itaipu that must be respected in Itaipu area.

- 1) The presence of athletes and team members without shirts will not be tolerated within Itaipu Area;
- 2) Cloth changes in the toilets or in the Teams Tents that will be installed, reminding all that, even though we can understand every nations or regions culture, in Brazil, getting naked in public is considered crime in Brazilian Laws Code according article 233 on the Crime Code;
- 3) Based on the same Brazilian Laws, to urinate in improper places (out of toilets) will not be tolerated as well;
- 4) The safety limits marked on the Lower Lake shall not be trespassed. Any person in disobedience to these limits will loose the accreditation and will be required to leave Itaipu Area;
- 5) The boats must be stored by the Teams Tents in appropriated place, designed by organization.
- 6) Access to the lakes and course will demand the usage of buoyancy jackets and other safety equipments;
- 7) Any other act that may be considered disrespectful or affront to Itaipu or Brazilian behavior principles
- 8) Official Training time: everyday from 8:30 a.m. to 17:30 p.m. according to training schedule with one hour per session.

# Terms Acceptance

Organization will not hesitate to cancel accreditation already issued in order to keep the minimum respect to our host, Itaipu Binational, in whose property we are practicing our sport, such a unique place deserves that we preserve the continuity of slalom in the Piracema Park.

In case we are obliged to cancel any accreditation and, if this accreditation is not delivered to the organization, all persons will be nominally checked at the Itaipu entrance, meaning that all of us will suffer the consequences of these irresponsible acts, with unnecessary delays to arrive to the course. Now this control is only by the visualization of the accreditation card, very quick and comfortable for all.

We really hope it won't be necessary to cancel any accreditation, with discomfort to all. We wish to have everyone respecting the behavior principles to make everyone's stay easier and fun.

The Brazilian Canoe Confederation once again thanks all in advance for the understanding expecting to have our message reaching its purposes this time.

Let's enjoy this place with joy and respect, for the continuity of slalom in the Piracema Park.

We are sure that all athletes and delegation members will respect and understand the rules and principles here imposed, consolidating an excellent slalom training option in the very near future.
